

## Digital platform for secondary school teachers on adolescent risk behaviours

The Laboratory for Prevention Research (PrevLab), Department of Behavioral Disorders, Faculty of Education and Rehabilitation Sciences at the University of Zagreb, is participating in the project **Digital platform for secondary school teachers on adolescent risk behaviours**, which started in November 2023 and will last until the end of April 2026. The lider for the whole project is the UTRIP Institute (Slovenia). The project leader for PrevLab (ERF, UNIZG) is Prof. Martina Ferić, PhD and the Associates in the project are Matea Belošević, PhD and Katarina Serdar, mag. paed. soc. Seven partners from the European Union are participating in the project. This project was funded by the Erasmus+ programme (KA220-SCH - Cooperation partnerships in school education).

The aim of the project is to meet the training needs of secondary school teachers in the EU in relation to the prevention of adolescent risk behaviours. To achieve this, the project partners will create a Digital Platform for secondary school teachers with online training on this topic, tools for the design and implementation of prevention systems in their schools, and a collection of good practices and policy recommendations.

To achieve the objective described above, the project partners will carry out the following activities:

- Create the first version of the digital platform for secondary school teachers, which will be translated into 6 languages;
- Carry out a trial implementation in 5 countries to assess the quality of the digital platform and identify aspects that need to be improved;
- Improve the Digital Platform in line with the results of the Trial implementation and disseminate the final version in 6 languages across the EU.

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
